Sports Games Award

We are delighted to announce that Newlyn School has achieved the School Games Gold Mark Award for the 2021/22 academic year. The School Games Mark is a Government-led award scheme launched in 2012, facilitated by the Youth Sport Trust to reward and recognise school's engagement (provision and uptake) in the School Games against a national benchmark and to celebrate keeping young people active, and we are delighted to have been recognised for our success. Our physical activity and school sport achievements this year included:

- 95% of Year 6 Pupils could swim a minimum of 25m.
- 100% of children participated in 120 minutes of curriculum PE each week

- Each cohort improved their Average Point Scores compared to the previous year when assessed against the REAL PE assessment wheel

- We offered at least 2 after school clubs to each year group that promoted Health and Well-being - 87% of children took part in at least 1 after school club that promoted Health and Well-being

- We purchased additional equipment to support PE curriculum and after school clubs
